An employee reported to us that they were diagnosed with (not tested for) COVID-19 on 04/09/20. The employee last worked prior to the diagnosis on 03/25/20. The employee returned to work on 5/4/20.

We closed the facility on 04/09/20 at 3:00 PM to clean and disinfect as per CDC guidelines.

We re-opened on 04/10/20 at 3:00 PM after thoroughly cleaning and disinfecting the facility as per CDC guidelines.

A 2<sup>nd</sup> employee reported to us that they tested positive for COVID-19 on 04/21/20. The employee last worked prior to the test on 04/20/20. The employee returned to work on 5/9/20.

We closed the facility on 04/21/20 at 10:30 AM to clean and disinfect as per CDC guidelines.

We re-opened on 05/4/20 at 7:00 AM after thoroughly cleaning and disinfecting the facility as per CDC guidelines.

A 3<sup>rd</sup> employee reported to us that they tested positive for COVID-19 on 05/09/20. The employee last worked prior to the test on 05/07/20. The employee returned to work on 5/25/20.

We closed the facility on 05/09/20 at 7:30 PM to clean and disinfect as per CDC guidelines.

A 4<sup>th</sup> employee reported to us that they tested positive for COVID-19 on 05/11/20. The employee last worked prior to the test on 05/08/20. The employee returned to work on 5/25/20.

We re-opened on 05/23/20 at 7:00 AM after thoroughly cleaning and disinfecting the facility as per CDC guidelines.

A 5<sup>th</sup> employee reported to us that they tested positive for COVID-19 on 06/19/20. The employee last worked prior to the test on 06/15/20.

We closed the facility on 06/19/20 at 10:30 AM to clean and disinfect as per CDC guidelines.

We re-opened on 06/20/20 at 3:00 PM after thoroughly cleaning and disinfecting the facility as per CDC guidelines.

A 6<sup>th</sup> employee reported to us that they tested positive for COVID-19 on 07/16/20. The employee last worked prior to the test on 06/27/20.

Based on CDC guidance, since this employee had not been at the facility for 7 days it is not necessary to close for sanitization.

A 7<sup>th</sup> employee reported to us that they tested positive for COVID-19 on 08/12/20. The employee last worked prior to the test on 08/05/20.

Based on CDC guidance, since this employee had not been at the facility for 7 days it is not necessary to close for sanitization.
