An employee reported to us that they tested positive for COVID-19 on 05/06/20. The employee last worked prior to the test on 05/05/20.

We closed the facility on 05/06/20 at 9:00 PM to clean and disinfect as per CDC guidelines.

We re-opened on 05/21/20 at 7:00 AM after thoroughly cleaning and disinfecting the facility as per CDC guidelines.

A 2nd employee reported to us that they tested positive for COVID-19 on 5/21/20. The employee last worked prior to the test on 05/21/20.

We closed the facility on 5/21/20 at 3:15 PM to clean and disinfect as per CDC guidelines.

We re-opened on 06/04/20 at 7:00 AM after thoroughly cleaning and disinfecting the facility as per CDC guidelines.

A 3rd employee reported to us that they tested positive for COVID-19 on 07/14/20. The employee last worked prior to the test on 07/06/20.

Based on CDC guidance, since these employees had not been at the facility for over 7 days it not necessary to close for sanitization.

A 4th employee reported to us that they tested positive for COVID-19 on 07/16/20. The employee last worked prior to the test on 07/16/20.

We closed the facility on 7/16/20 at 8:00 PM to clean and disinfect as per CDC guidelines.

We re-opened on 07/20/20 at 7:00 AM after thoroughly cleaning and disinfecting the facility as per CDC guidelines.

A 5th employee reported to us that they tested positive for COVID-19 on 7/17/20. The employee last worked prior to the test on 07/15/20.

Based on CDC guidance, this employee had not been at the facility since it had been closed and disinfected so it was not necessary to extend the locations closure for sanitization.

A 6th employee reported to us that they tested positive for COVID-19 on 8/07/20. The employee last worked prior to the test on 08/03/20.

We closed the facility on 8/7/20 at 7:30 PM to clean and disinfect as per CDC guidelines.

We re-opened on 08/09/20 at 7:00 AM after thoroughly cleaning and disinfecting the facility as per CDC guidelines.

A 7th employee reported to us that they tested positive for COVID-19 on 08/13/20. The employee last worked prior to the test on 08/07/20.

Based on CDC guidance, this employee had not been at the facility since it had been closed and disinfected so it was not necessary to close for sanitization.
